This is a follow-up to last week's September newsletter to give further information about some of the items included. It's been a very busy but very positive start to the new term. Everybody is working hard and systems are starting to fall into place.

Meet the Teacher Evening : Monday 19th September from 3.30 (Meet in the school hall)

Parents will have the chance to hear about the school's aims, ethos and values as well as other whole-school issues before going to individual classrooms for a brief talk with teachers. You will be able to have a look at your child's books to see what they have been doing since they returned to school. You will be able to find out about what is expected of them this year and how you might help. Parents with pupils in more than one class across the school can decide which to visit first and then move on. The class-based sessions will be quite informal.

Reading Club for Years 1, 2 and 3 : Wednesdays 3.20 - 4.20

Miss Parker will run this after-school club which will revolve around stories and books. There will be a story each week, then some exciting follow-up activities involving arts & crafts. Parents are invited to come along and take part or to help. The children attending this club will think of a name for it.

Homework Club for Years 4, 5 and 6 : Wednesdays 3.20 - 4.20

Mrs Tateson will run this after-school club in which pupils will complete tasks or projects designed to help them in different aspects of their learning. The aim of this club is to give pupils the space, time and resources to complete homework that has been set by their teachers. Parents or family members are very welcome to come in and work/learn alongside the children.

Football Coaching (starting Wednesday 21st September)

From next week, on Wednesdays, there will be football coaching in the Autumn Term. This will always take place outdoors and will stop when we break for Christmas if the weather allows. The football coaching is for Key Stage 2 pupils who can commit to coming along to training every week and help us to maintain the success we had last year with our school football team.

Key Stage 1 After-School Sport (Tuesdays)

This after-school session is now open to Years 1, 2 and 3. From next week, Year 3 pupils will be allowed to attend Tuesday Sport Club.
