The school's Eco Team will be going for the Green Flag Award this term. As part of their recycling activities, they are collecting used pens which can be exchanged for cash. Please send in any old pens (biros or felt tips) to add to our pen-recycling bin.

#### Free School Meal Entitlement

The DFE has changed the criteria for this. I have copied the section of a document received for your information.

#### FREE SCHOOL MEAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Universal Credit with an earnings threshold that does not exceed £7,400 as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods
- Income Support
- Income based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit, provided you are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income, as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs, that does not exceed £16,190
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Where a parent is entitled to Working Tax Credit run-on (the payment someone receives for a further four weeks after they stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit).
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.

#### Universal Free School Meals and Pupil Premium

All infant pupils (Reception to Year 2) are entitled to a free meal regardless of the above FSM eligibility. I am attaching a letter for you to read which contains a form to complete. It is really important that we know which of our pupils are actually entitled to a free meal even if you as parents choose the packed-lunch option.

This is because all pupils who are eligible for free meals attract additional funding known as 'Pupil Premium' and this is currently £1,300 per child. The school needs all the funding it can get as costs rise and budgets are cut. We can only receive the funding if pupils are known to be eligible.

Please take the time to complete the form attached so we do not miss out. For example, if just 5 pupils who are eligible are not known to us that would mean a 'loss' of £6.500.

Last year we raised over £1500 for this worthwhile cause. We hope to match or even beat that total this year.
